A SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM FOR KIDS AGED 9 - 14

Kraftworks for Kids is looking for people with an aptitude for figurine painting and an interest in teaching and supervising kids to become Junior Leaders and work with us over the school holidays.

Our program is based around art and craft activities, in particular scale-modelling. Most activities are based around a kit. When the child joins the program they choose a kit from amongst the hundreds available. They then work on that kit, assembling and painting it under the supervision of a Leader. A Leader is responsible for one table with up to six children. Where practical we put kids who are working on the same type of kit on the same table.

The Junior Leader working hours are generally 8:00 - 17:00 or 9:00 to 18:00 with an hour for lunch.

To work at Kraftworks for Kids you must:

Enjoy working with kids.

Have some aptitude for at least one of the activities in the program.

Have your Working With Children card. We'll help you get one if you don't have one.

Attend a training day. We offer many different activities at Kraftworks for Kids and our Leaders need to have some degree of familiarity with all of the activities.
